Career Upskilling Program Professional English Module Jilin University – 3rd Group February 22 – March 4, 2021

Course Content:

Three key areas of professional practice covered:

- a. Module 1: Participating in and Managing Meetings
 This module will develop the communicative skills required to participate in and manage meetings in different professional settings: (a) Communicative language; (b) Participating in discussions; (c) Socialising Greetings and small talk; (d) Agendas; (e) Minutes and (f) Summarising.
- b. Module 2: Professional writing This module will focus on improving the writing skills required to communicate successfully in professional and academic contexts across different writing genres: Emails, Reports, Proposals, Academic and Business Writing Styles and Editing.
- c. Module 3: Giving Presentations/Public Speaking This module will focus on training users in the formal structure of a presentation and the language required to plan, prepare, and deliver a presentation in English. Part of this module will include structured workshops with students and teachers.
- d. Summative assessment This component includes oral presentation.

Mode of Delivery:

Online via the video conferencing platform Zoom.

Program Timing:

The program consists of 14-hour lessons and 4-hour assessments, which develop participants' ability to use English interactively in written and face to face communications.
